Must be merino hoggets, 2017 drop, lambs teeth.

Maximum of 2 groups per exhibitor per section

Month of drop/date of shearing & average rainfall to be shown

Advise of number of groups entered

There will be 3 sections

Sheep to be yarded by 12:45pm

Angaston Bureau (members only)
